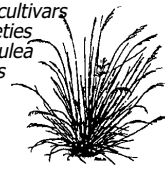

Yellow Foxtail - Very Hardy 🌿 #6641
1 gal. - \$10.99
Alopecurus pratensis aureus. Foliage 30cm. Flowers 60cm. Spacing 45cm. Golden foliage and buff flowerheads, early summer. Good for mass planting. Cut back once in early summer because foliage will sprawl.

Big Blue Stem - Very Hardy 🌿 #6642
4" - \$4.99 1 gal. - \$10.99
Andropogon gerardii. Foliage 180cm. Flowers 240cm. Spacing 100cm. Native prairie grass. Best in large groups. Dark red colouring throughout. The spreading flowerheads resemble a 'turkey's foot'.

Little Blue Stem - Very Hardy 🌿 #5689
4" pot - \$4.99, 1 gal. - \$10.99
Andropogon scoparius (Schizachyrium) 90cm. Spacing 45cm. Bluish foliage is red in fall. Silvery inflorescence on the length of the stem. A native prairie grass that is worth perpetuating.

Little Blue Stem - Very Hardy 🌿 #P3964
4" pot - \$4.99, 1 gal. - \$12.99,
Andropogon scoparius 'The Blues'. 90cm tall. Spacing 60cm. A native clump forming grass with silvery tufts along the stem in late fall. Rich bronze autumn colour.

Tuberous Oat Grass - Hardy 🌿 #6644
1 gal. - \$12.99,
Arrhenatherum elatius bulbosum 'Variegata'. Foliage 30cm. Flowers 45cm. Spacing 30cm. White/green striped leaves. Good rock garden plant. Cut back once after flowering.

Variegated Giant Reed -Tender 🌿 #7015
2 gal. - \$18.99, 5 gal - \$59.99
Arundo donax variegatus. 2 to 3 m. Spacing 90cm. A bamboo-like fast growing grass with leaves boldly striped in green and white. Not locally hardy, winter indoors. Spectacular grass for full sun.

Side Oats Grama - Very Hardy 🌿 #6650
1 gal. - \$10.99
Bouteloua curtipendula (B. racemosa) 60 to 90cm. Spacing 60cm. The interesting florets are held to one side of the stem. Hardy native grass. Used for dried flower arrangements. Purple to copper-red fall colour.

Mosquito Grass - Very Hardy 🌿 #5678
4" pot - \$2.99, 1 gal - \$8.99
Bouteloua gracilis. 60cm tall. Spacing 45cm. Brown insect-like spikelets are horizontally attached to the erect stems. Beautiful in dried flower arrangements. Good rock garden plant. A native grass.

Golden Brome - Very Hardy 🌿 #6652
1 gal - \$10.99
Bromus inermis 'Skinner's Golden'. 60 to 90cm. Spacing 60cm. Strong gold stripes throughout the foliage. Drought tolerant. Introduced from Northern Manitoba.

Feather Reed Grass - Very Hardy 🌿 #7037
4" pot - \$4.99, 1 gal. - \$12.99
Calamagrostis acutiflora stricta. Spacing 90cm. Strong vertical line to 150cm. Slender yellow-buff flower spikes from June onwards. Bright gold colour lasts well into winter.

Variegated Feather Reed Grass 🌿 #P4952
Very Hardy
1 gal. - \$14.99
Calamagrostis acutiflora 'Avalanche' 120-150 cm Spacing 90cm. A white centred variegated 'Karl Foerster'. Sun or partial sun.

Eldorado Feather Reed Grass 🌿 #P5155
1 gal. - \$16.99
Calamagrostis acutiflora 'Eldorado' 1.2-1.5m tall. Spacing 1m. New and rare gold variegated form of the very popular Karl Foerster grass.

Feather Reed Grass - Very Hardy 🌿 #6653
Perennial Plant of the Year 2001
1 gal. - \$12.99, 2 gal. - \$22.99, 3 gal. - \$27.99
Calamagrostis arundinacea 'Karl Foerster' 120 to 150cm. Spacing 90cm. Clump-forming with a strong vertical line. Slender yellow-buff flower spikes in early summer. Cone is seedless and sterile.

Variegated Reed Grass - Very Hardy 🌿 #6197
1 gal. - \$14.99, 2 gal. - \$22.99
Calamagrostis arundinacea 'Overdam'. Foliage 60cm. Spacing 60cm. Flowers 120cm. Emergent leaves have yellow margin and stripes becoming white with pink flush. Purplish flowers turn pink.

Autumn Reed Grass - Very Hardy 🌿 #7038
1 gal. - \$12.99, 2 gal - \$22.99
Calamagrostis brachytricha (Achnatherum b.). 120cm tall. Spacing 60cm. Very large, showy purple-pink flower heads in Sept./Oct. Upright vertical habit. Excellent in winter gardens and dried arrangements.

Northern Sea Oats - Hardy 🌿 #6710
1 gal. - \$8.99
Chasmanthium latifolium (Uniola). Foliage 90cm. Flowers 110m. Spacing 60cm. Upright clump with panicles of nodding flat seed heads that appear in July and persist into winter. Good for drying.

Pink Pampas Grass - Tender #2755
1 gal. - \$14.99
Cortaderia selloana 'Pink'. Spacing 180 cm. Flowers 240 cm. Foliage 180 cm. Very showy pink plumes in September. Not hardy. Cut back and pot up for winter storage indoors. Full sun.

Pampas Grass - Tender #2756
1 gal - \$12.99, 2 gal. - \$22.99
Cortaderia selloana 'White'. Foliage 180cm. Flowers 240cm. Spacing 180cm. Not hardy in Ontario. Cut back and pot up in fall, winter indoors. White plumes like ostrich feathers. King of Ornamental Grasses.

Lemon Grass - Tender #7036
1 gal - \$12.99
Cymbopogon citratus. 90cm. Not hardy. Usually container grown as a greenhouse plant. Used as flavouring in Asiatic cookery, particularly Vietnamese.

TUFTED HAIR GRASS(DESCHAMPSIA) 🌿
The various cultivars of *Deschampsia* may at first seem rather similar but each has its own special colour difference at flowering time. This can be best appreciated when two or three types are grouped together in the garden. They prefer moist soil in sun or partial shade and are good plants for areas getting only part-day sun.

Deschampsia - Northern Lights - #P4413
Very Hardy
1 gal. - \$16.99
Deschampsia caespitosa 'Northern Lights'. 30cm tall. Spacing 45cm. Very striking clump grass with variegated foliage. Shows a pink blush in spring and in cool fall weather. Full sun or partial shade.

Tufted Hair Grass - Very Hardy #7041
1 gal. - \$12.99
Deschampsia caespitosa. Foliage 45cm. Flowers 90cm. Spacing 60cm. Densely tufted dark green foliage. Light buff coloured panicles in mid-summer persisting into fall.

Deschampsia Bronzeschleier - #6662
Very Hardy
1 gal. - \$12.99
Deschampsia caespitosa 'Bronzeschleier'. Foliage 45cm. Flowers 90cm. Spacing 60cm. Densely tufted grass with bronze seed heads on 100cm stems. Good for flower arrangements.

Deschampsia Goldgehaenge - #6663
Very Hardy
1 gal. - \$12.99
Deschampsia caespitosa 'Goldgehaenge'. Foliage 45cm. Flowers 90cm. Spacing 60cm. Densely tufted dark green grass with bright yellow seed heads. Use with perennials or groundcover. Mid-June flowering.

Deschampsia Tautreger-Very Hardy #6634
4" pot - \$4.99, 1 gal - \$12.99
Deschampsia caespitosa 'Tautreger'. Foliage 45cm. Flowers 90cm. Spacing 60cm. Late blooming variety with golden panicles. Moist soil will keep the foliage a rich green.

Plume Grass - Hardy #6667
1 gal. - \$12.99, 2 gal. - \$18.99
Erianthus ravennae. 2 to 3m. Flower spikes 5m. Spacing 120cm. Silver-white flower heads in late September. Foliage has good fall colours.

FESCUE - (FESTUCA) 🌿
Festuca are evergreen clump-forming grasses. Excellent as groundcover, border edging or in the rock garden. They vary considerably in colour and texture. The bluest colour is found in **Blue Finch** and **Elijah Blue**. They are best in full sun in well-drained soil and should be cut back in March before new growth begins.

Boulder Blue Fescue - Very Hardy #P4572
1 gal. - \$14.99
Festuca 'Boulder Blue'. Spacing 30 cm. Evergreen foliage of intense blue. Compact clump forming grass. Full Sun.

Blue Finch Fescue - Very Hardy #7004
1 gal. - \$12.99
Festuca cinerea 'Blau Fink'
Flowers 40cm, Spacing 40cm. Clump-forming intense silver-blue. Perhaps the bluest of the blue fescue. Very desirable. Showy in rock garden with small evergreens. Full sun. Very hardy grass.

Blue Fox Fescue - Hardy #6677
1 gal - \$12.99
Festuca cinerea 'Blaufuchs'
Flowers 40 cm. Spacing 30 cm. Blue fescue with very bright silvery-blue colour. Good combination with dwarf conifers. Full sun. Needs good drainage in winter. Very hardy grass.

Elijah Blue Fescue - Hardy #6984
1 gal. - \$12.99
Festuca cinerea 'Elijah Blue'. 30cm tall. Flowers 40cm. Spacing 40cm. Excellent blue-foliage evergreen grass. One of the very bluest grasses.

Solling Fescue - Hardy #6893
1 gal. - \$12.99
Festuca cinerea 'Solling'. 20 cm tall. Spacing 30 cm. Good clump-forming blue fescue. Foliage stays good looking all year. Does not usually flower. Full sun. Needs excellent drainage in winter.

Pepindale Blue - Hardy #POG0030
1 gal. - \$12.99
Festuca glauca 'Pepindale Blue' 20 cm tall. Spacing 45 cm. Outstanding in perennial or rock gardens, mixed landscape plantings, or as a small scale groundcover. Remove faded flowers to promote foliage growth. Tolerant of dry, poor soil. Blooms early to midsummer. Plant in full sun. Prefers well-drained soil.

Sea Urchin Fescue - Very Hardy #6678
1 gal - \$12.99
Festuca glauca 'Seeigel'. 15cm tall. Flowers 25cm. Spacing 25cm. Silver-blue foliage. Combine with spring bulbs, annuals or in rock garden.

Skinner's Blue Fescue - Very Hardy #7044
1 gal - \$12.99
Festuca ovina glauca 'Skinner's'
Flowers 40cm, Spacing 40cm. An extremely hardy selection of blue fescue from Manitoba. Full sun. Provide good drainage in winter. Very hardy grass.

Hakone Grass - Very Hardy #P5009
1 gal - \$18.99
Hakonechloa macra 'Albo Striata' 30 cm tall. Exotic almost tropical looking grass with cascading green leaves with white edges. Excellent along the front edge of a shade bed.

Hakone Grass - Very Hardy #P5010
1 gal - \$18.99
Hakonechloa macra 'All Gold' 30 cm tall. From Japan comes this new all gold form of the Hakone grass. It has a similar growth rate to 'Aureola' but with a more upright habit.

Golden Hakonechloa - Very Hardy #6912
Perennial of the Year 2009
1 gal. - \$18.99
Hakonechloa macra 'Aureola'. 15 to 45cm tall. The foliage is bright yellow with fine green stripes. Use as an edging plant or accent plant in groups

Japanese Forest Grass #POG0034
1 gal. - \$18.99
Hakonechloa macra 'Beni Kaze'. 40-80 cm tall. Outstanding grass for the shade garden. Soft texture and natural wind-swept look. Attractive green foliage turns brilliant red in fall. Excellent mass planted with Ferns, Hostas or other shade loving perennials.

Blue Oat Grass - Very Hardy #6686
1 gal. - \$14.99
Helictotrichon sempervirens (Avenas)
60cm tall. Flowers 120cm. Spacing 90cm. Blue spike leaves turn brown in fall. Good winter interest. A zero maintenance grass.

Sapphire Blue Oat Grass-Very Hardy #P3968
1 gal. - \$14.99
Helictotrichon 'Sapphire'. Foliage height 60cm. Inflorescence to 90cm. Spacing 60cm. A very bright blue selection of Blue Oat Grass. Forms a dense clump. A zero maintenance grass.

Variiegated Velvet Grass - Hardy #6687
1 gal. - \$14.99
Holcus mollis 'Albovariegatus'. 10 to 30cm. Spacing 30cm. Low spreading with green/white striped leaves. Good rock garden plant. Best in sandy well drained soil but will suffer in heat if not shaded.

Bottlebrush Grass - Very Hardy #7011
4" pot - \$4.99, 1 gal. - \$10.99
Hystrix patula (*Asperella patula*). 100cm tall. Flowers 120cm. Spacing 45cm. Long bottlebrush flowerheads that are good for fresh or dried arrangements. Good drainage.

Japanese Blood Grass - Hardy #6688
4" pot - \$6.99, 1 gal. - \$16.99, 2 gal. - \$22.99
Imperata cylindrica rubra 'Red Baron'. 40cm. Spacing 40cm. Upright tufting grass with deep red colouring. Impressive when mass planted or in large clumps. No flowers. Soil should be moist, not dry.

June Grass - Very Hardy #6689
1 gal. - \$10.99
Koeleria glauca. Foliage 20cm. Flowers 40cm. Spacing 45cm. Small tufted grass with blue-green leaves. Good for border edging or rock garden.

Pearl Grass - Hardy #6690
1 gal. - \$14.99

Many texts that give hardiness ratings suggest the Lily Turfs are not hardy enough for our area. We can only say that we have grown them successfully over many years at our location in Brampton and have suffered no losses even over the severe winter of 1993-94. Their August-October flowers in shades of lavender, purple and pure white make them particularly valuable. They can be grown in sun or shade. Even in deep shade their flowering is not diminished. The foliage is totally evergreen which can contribute much to the winter landscape. The old leaves should be removed in spring before new growth appears.

OTHER GRASS-LIKE PERENNIALS

Many of our 'ornamental grasses' are neither true grasses or even true sedges. This is a very valuable group whose diversity of form and colour provide many more choices in finding 'the right plant for the right place'. Sweet Flags, Rushes and Bulrushes are generally regarded as water plants; those included here can be used in the regular garden. True, they would resent drying-out but not any more so than an Astilbe, Delphinium or most other perennials.



SWEET FLAG - (ACORUS)

Tolerates but does not require wet soil. Best in moist shade or partial shade. Sun tolerant in wet soil.

Sweet Flag - Very Hardy #5090/#7002

HARDY BAMBOO

The following tips are useful in growing Hardy Bamboo.

- 1) These varieties of Bamboo are hardy to Zone 5 and in some microclimates Zone 4. Toronto area is in Zone 6.
- 2) The *Phyllostachys* varieties need at least 3 to 4 hours of sun a day... the more the better.
- 3) Bamboo can reach a height of 5 - 6 m in an ideal situation, with the canes reaching a diameter of 3 cm.
- 4) Can be grown in most soil types but a heavy loam is best.
- 5) Bamboo is very drought tolerant, but when too dry the leaves will roll up into cylinders.

- 6) Moisture requirements are usually just regular watering practices once established.
- 7) Bamboo never needs to be cut down unless you feel it has become too tall.
- 8) Bamboo canes last approx. 7 years. New canes are produced every year so your Bamboo should last forever.
- 9) The *Phyllostachys* varieties produce runners in spring and early summer. If this creates problems then simply grow the Bamboo in a large pot sunk into the ground with a few drain holes. Bamboo is also easily overwintered in containers and planters above ground. Chances are, the pot of Bamboo you purchased, over-wintered in that pot.

- 10) Bamboo can be fertilized twice a year, in early spring and early summer, but fertilizing is not necessary.
- 11) Bamboo will remain green all year if it is kept out of the wind. Exposure to a lot of wind and dry conditions will turn the leaves brown. The plant will produce new leaves in the spring.
- 12) Bamboo can be grown indoors in bright light all year.

Glossy leathery leaves striped in cream. Many leaves entirely yellow with purple stems. Dwarf bushy groundcover for sun or shade. Mulch heavily and keep moist.
