INSECTS

We often forget that many insects found in our gardens are beneficial and may even be eliminating harmful bugs. Preventing insect problems from arising is usually the best approach, but it does require planning and effort. Keeping your yard clear of debris (such as leaves or fallen fruit) can eliminate food sources, and nesting spots. Please note, that ladybugs do benefit from clean, disease free leaf litter for overwintering.

All insects are part of the eco-system and they each play a role of some kind, but action may be required when we have an infestation.

With changes made to the Pesticide Act (effective April 22, 2009), your treatment options have changed. For details beyond what we can list here, please go to www.Ontario.ca/pesticideban.

Each situation is different and no one solution is necessarily the right one. We should realize that Mother Nature responds to population explosions of any organism, though more slowly than treatments. Its response is usually an offsetting explosion of predator populations, but this may take months or even years to occur. It should be noted that many organic or safe solutions require multiple applications and may not be effective on some insects.

DISEASES

It may seem strange to think that plants get fungal, bacterial, and viral infections, but diseases are all around us in the soil, water, and air.

A common misconception is that the plant is somehow to blame, by being weak or of poor quality. The fact is that plants are like people; even healthy ones can become ill.

A healthier plant is more likely to resist some diseases and certain varieties have been found to be more disease resistant than others. Some diseases occur only occasionally, while others may return year after year. This can be due to environmental or climatic conditions and/or the nature of the specific variety of plant.

Matching the correct plant to the conditions you have gives it the best chance of being strong and healthy. By looking at things like temperature, soil condition, drainage, available light and airflow, you can avoid stressing the plant and making it more susceptible to infection. Keeping your yard clean and tidy will also remove a potential breeding ground for diseases.

If disease does occur, don't panic - they are rarely fatal to the plant. Try to bring a fresh sample of the leaf or branch to Humber Nurseries for identification. We will provide solutions to the more common diseases you may encounter in your garden.
