The majority of plants listed grow naturally in Ontario. Some are hardy in this province but may come from a more western or southern area. It is of course not merely sufficient that plants be native but also that they be appropriate to the site – dry grassland, shady woods, pond side, wet areas, etc.

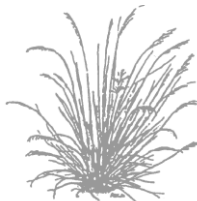

For purposes of the above list, a native plant is considered to be a species which existed in what is now (eastern, with exceptions) North America prior to the arrival of European settlers (as opposed to a naturalized plant which has escaped into a new habitat because of human influence). More precisely, a native plant is one that has proven its adaptability to our climate, soils, pathogens and other indigenous species over many thousands of years.

We encourage you NOT to dig native plants from wild populations due to the serious ethical, legal and scientific considerations involved. Instead, choose to preserve existing indigenous plants for future generations and purchase well-grown nursery propagated native species. Such plants have been cultivated and managed to assure successful transplanting and are not only good value in the longer term, but their purchase will encourage the production and availability of even more native plants.
