Mint green foliage with arching form to 100 cm tall. Perfect height for placement under windows.

(100cm spread) Zone 5 - Compact spreading evergreen with bright yellow-green foliage. 60 cm high.

(150 cm spread) Zone 2 - Fine feathery green foliage turns a rich plum colour in winter. A good compact spreader. 50 cm tall.

Microbiota decussata (150 cm spread) Zone 4
Hardy ground cover with bright green cedar-like foliage turning bronze in winter. 30 cm tall.

SPRUCE – DWARF FORMS

Dwarf spruces are ideal for smaller gardens, foundation or cemetery plantings, or rock gardens. Plant in rich, moist, well-drained, acidic soil.

Little Gem ☉☐ #PICABLG

Picea abies 'Little Gem' (50 cm) Zone 3
Dwarf globe shape with very dense foliage that never needs pruning. Good in rock gardens.

Nest Spruce ☉☐ #PICABNI

Picea abies 'Nidiformis' (125 cm spread) Zone 3
Slow-growing, low, flat-topped evergreen that needs no pruning and has dark green needles.

Picea glauca 'Conica' (2 m) Zone 4
Slow-growing dense pyramidal conifer with bright green foliage that needs no pruning and is shade tolerant. A traditional favourite.

Dwarf Serbian Spruce ☉☐ #PICOMNA

Picea omorika 'Nana' (100 cm) Zone 4
Beautiful slow-growing dense globe. The undersides of the needles are blue-white and quite showy.

Creeping Colorado Blue Spruce  **#PICPUCR**

Picea pungens 'Procumbens' (3 m spread) Zone 3
Low creeping evergreen with silver-blue foliage. Branches may be pendulous or stiffly horizontal. Ideal for draping over rocks or walls.

PINE – Dwarf Forms

Dwarf varieties are suitable for small gardens, rock gardens and foundation plantings. The growth rate of pines is easily controlled by removing part of the candle-like new growth in spring.

Mugho Pine   **#PINMUMU**

Pinus mugo mugo (150 cm) Zone 1
Compact mounding evergreen with dark green needles. Ideal for foundation and rockery plantings. Prune annually for bushiness and to maintain dwarf habit.

Dwarf Mugho Pine   **#PINMUPU**

Pinus mugo 'Pumilio' (1 m) Zone 1
Slow growing compact mounding dwarf pine suitable for foundation plantings and rock gardens.

Pinus strobus 'Blue Shag' (100 cm) Zone 3
Dwarf compact rounded evergreen with soft blue-green foliage. Prefers rich, moist, well-drained, acidic soil. Excellent foundation or accent plant.

Dwarf White Pine   **#PINSTNA**

Pinus strobus 'Nana' (1 m) Zone 3
Dwarf compact rounded evergreen with soft blue-green needles. Ideal foundation or accent plant. Prefers rich, moist, well-drained, acidic soil.

YEW  

Unsurpassed for the ability to prosper in sun or shade and can be formally clipped to maintain height or spread. The Yew is tolerant of city conditions and its dense dark green foliage makes for a superb hedge. Yews require well-drained soil.

Dwarf Golden Yew  **#TAXCUAU**

Taxus cuspidata 'Aurescens' (150 cm) Zone 5
Very slow-growing variety that needs full sun to retain its bright gold colour. New growth is bright golden-yellow maturing to deep green after first season. 40 cm tall.

Clipped Pyramidal Yew **#TAXCUPY**

Taxus cuspidata 'Capitata' (2-3 m) Zone 4
Ideal for foundation plantings with any exposure including deep shade. Annual trimming required to maintain formal conical form.

Clipped Globe Yew **#TAXCUGL**

Taxus cuspidata 'Clipped Globe' (150 cm) Zone 4
Dense dark green foliage clipped to globular form and is ideal for foundation plantings. Trim to maintain desired shape.

Emerald Spreader Yew **#TAXCUES**

Taxus cuspidata 'Monloo' (80 cm) Zone 5
Slow growing with flat-topped form and inedible red berries. Ideal for ground cover. Spreads to 3 m.

Taxus cuspidata 'Nana' (100 cm) Zone 4

Hill's Yew **#TAXMEHL**

Taxus media 'Hillii' (250 cm) Zone 5
Compact columnar form. Excellent low maintenance hedge plant with dark green foliage. Usually fruitless but inedible red berries may occur on female plants. 1 m wide.

Ward's Yew **#TAXMEWA**

Taxus media 'Ward's' (125 cm spread) Zone 5
Irregular spreading to semi-globular habit with rich dark green foliage and inedible red berries. Sun or shade. 1 m high.

CEDAR  

Upright forms are often used as specimens, wind-breaks, screens and hedges, while dwarf forms are ideal for foundation plantings. Cedars will thrive in sun or partial shade where soil moisture is adequate.

Thuja occidentalis (12 m) Zone 2
Selected nursery-grown native cedar ideal for screen or hedge. Can be maintained at any height. 2 m wide.

Degroot Spire Cedar **#THUOCDG**

Thuja occidentalis 'Degroot's Spire' (3 m) Zone 3
Distinctively narrow pyramidal selection with finely textured dark green foliage. Slow growing.

Jantar Cedar  **#THUOCJA**

Thuja occidentalis 'Jantar' (150 cm) Zone 4
Narrow pyramidal habit with dense golden-yellow foliage. Best colour in full sun. 50-60 cm wide.

Thuja occidentalis 'Smaragd' (2-3 m) Zone 4
Slow-growing natural pyramid with rich emerald-green foliage. Very popular and requires little pruning.

Wintergreen Cedar **#THUOCWG**

Thuja occidentalis 'Wintergreen' (6-10 m) Zone 4
Pyramidal habit with deep green foliage. Holds green colour well in winter. 1.5-3 m wide.

DWARF FORMS**Hetz Midget** **#THUOCHM**

Thuja occidentalis 'Hetz Midget' (40 cm)
A dwarf, compact form of white cedar or arborvitae. Plant in full sun to part shade and in average, moist yet well drained soil. Will tolerate air pollution and juglone from Black Walnut and related trees.

Little Giant Globe Cedar **#THUOCLG**

Thuja occidentalis 'Little Giant' (100 cm) Zone 3
Compact dwarf globe that stays bright green in winter. No pruning required.

Thuja occidentalis 'Woodwardii Aurea' (100 cm) Zone 3 - A golden variety of the ever popular globe cedar. Excellent winter colour.

DWARF HEMLOCK  

Many dwarf forms are now available and their ability to thrive in sun or shade permits their use in almost every garden situation. Hemlock prefer rich, moist, acidic, well-drained soil and are not tolerant of wind or drought. Slow-growing.

Jeddeloh Dwarf Hemlock **#TSUCAJE**

Tsuga canadensis 'Jeddeloh' (50 cm) Zone 4
Mounding habit with soft green foliage. Ideal for rock gardens. 100 cm wide.

A beautiful pendulous form with broad arching branches. Can be staked upright. 2-3 m wide
