Soft-needled conifers that include stately tall growing varieties suitable as lawn specimens and dwarf varieties for foundation plantings and rock gardens. Prefer rich, moist, well-drained, acidic soil.



#### 🍁 **Balsam Fir** ☉ ● #ABIBA

*Abies balsamea* (20 m) Zone 5  
Popular native conifer often used as a Christmas tree. Dark green soft foliage with sweet resinous aroma and a narrow symmetrical form. Prefers moist soil. 3-6 m wide. Most shade tolerant fir.
