HYBRID TEA ROSES

No guarantee over winter

Hybrid Tea Roses are generally tall and stately with large well-formed blossoms borne singly on long stems. They are excellent as single specimens or in mixed plantings. They are generally considered to be 'the classic rose' and favoured for cutting and flower arrangements.

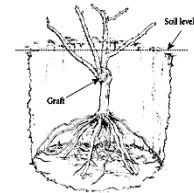
HOW TO PLANT ROSES IN ONTARIO

Select a site in full sun (at least 6 hours) with rich, well-drained soil. In general, the more sun, the better.

Prepare the soil well to a depth of at least 50 cm. Sandy loam enriched with humus (such as composted manure) and bone meal is best.

Plant the rose so that the bud union (the swollen portion at the bottom of the canes) is about 5 cm below the soil. If the plant is in a plastic pot, gently remove it from the container before planting. If the plant is in a fibre pot, break off the rim down to the soil level and make 3 or 4 slits in the side of the pot. DO NOT REMOVE THE POT.

After planting, water well and use transplant fertilizer once a week for the next six weeks.

HOW TO PREVENT AND TREAT COMMON ROSE PROBLEMS

PROBLEM	SYMPTOMS & CONDITION	PREVENTION	TREATMENT (From least to most toxic)
<p>Aphids</p> 	<p>Small sucking insects—green, brown, or reddish—thrive in cool weather and attack and disfigure new growth.</p>	<p>Encourage or release beneficial insects such as lacewings, ladybugs and parasitic wasps, which prey on aphids.</p>	<p>Knock off aphids with strong streams of water. Treat with insecticidal soap.</p>
<p>Black Spot</p> 	<p>Circular black spots with yellow halos appear; leaves may turn yellow and drop prematurely. Bacterial spores are spread by rain or splashing water; disease thrives in warm, humid weather.</p>	<p>Water early in the day and ensure adequate air circulation around plants. Spray leaves every two weeks with a mixture of 1 tbsp. baking soda and 2 1/2 tbsp. ultrafine horticultural oil in a gallon of water.</p>	<p>Remove and destroy infected leaves and canes. Spray with sulphur. In fall, rake up all dropped leaves to avoid overwintering bacteria.</p>
<p>Powdery Mildew</p> 	<p>White powdery fungi distort foliage and stunt new growth. Windborne spores germinate under high humidity but are inhibited by rain.</p>	<p>Ensure adequate air circulation around plants. Spray leaves every 1 to 2 weeks with a mixture of 1 tbsp. baking soda and 1 1/2 tbsp. ultrafine horticultural oil in a gallon of water, or spray leaves with water early in the morning.</p>	<p>Spray with sulphur or a bio-fungicide.</p>
<p>Rose Rust</p> 	<p>This fungus appears as pinhead-sized, orange dots on underside of leaf and yellow mottling on upper surface. Wet conditions support infection.</p>	<p>Ensure adequate air circulation. Since rust overwinters on fallen leaves, remove and destroy all infected leaves. To deter future outbreaks, replace mulch before new growth emerges.</p>	<p>Spray with sulphur or a bio-fungicide.</p>
<p>Scale</p> 	<p>Small waxy hard or soft bodied insects settle on leaves and shoots and suck plant juices, causing stunted plant growth. They may be black, brown, gray, red or white.</p>	<p>Encourage or release lacewings which prey on these pests. Prune and discard badly infected plant parts.</p>	<p>Spray with horticultural oil, insecticidal soap or lime-sulphur.</p>
<p>Spider Mites</p> 	<p>These relatives of the spider puncture the undersides of foliage and suck out the juices, leaving foliage looking mottled. They spin fine webs on leaves and shoots.</p>	<p>Mites thrive in hot, dry weather, so spray roses with cold water during dry spells, allowing enough time for them to dry by nightfall. Since adult mites overwinter on leaves of weeds, keep beds weed-free.</p>	<p>Treat with horticultural oil or insecticidal soap.</p>
<p>Thrips</p> 	<p>Tiny, elongated, yellowish-brown or black insects with feathery wings may disfigure flowers with brownish streaks or edges, bumps or spots.</p>	<p>Encourage or release beneficial insects such as lacewings and ladybugs. Prune affected plant parts.</p>	<p>Dust under leaves with diatomaceous earth or treat with insecticidal soap or horticultural oil.</p>
