Acer palmatum Zone 5

Unsurpassed specimen plant which deserves a place in every garden. Available in upright or weeping cutleaf forms with green, red or variegated foliage. Prefers slightly acidic well drained soil which is moderately and constantly moist. Fertilizer requirements are minimal—once only in early spring with water soluble all-purpose plant food. Japanese Maples are subject to very few pests.

Mulch roots and protect with burlap in winter.

HYDRANGEA

A genus of long-lived flowering shrubs and climbers that do best in rich, moist, well-drained soil. In the heat of summer, additional irrigation is often necessary and mulch will aid in conserving moisture. They grow well in sun or part shade provided that adequate moisture is maintained.


BIG LEAF HYDRANGEA (<i>Hydrangea macrophylla</i>)
